

What is a Dental Implant?

A dental implant is an artificial "root" system comprised of a titanium screw coupled with a prosthetic tooth. The implant, which is lodged in the jaw, operates completely independently from your other teeth, giving it a secure fit and realistic look.

Why Dental Implants?

Dental implants can be used to solve a number of dental impairments including:

- Missing or Broken Teeth
- A Rotted or Brittle Tooth
- As an alternate to dentures

Typically dental implants are the best permanent solution for a picture-perfect smile, and are considered one of the best investments for your overall oral health and longevity of your teeth.

The All-on-FourTM Process

Permanent Dental Implants have been described as the ultimate dental implant solution. Using a new innovative technology called All-on-Four[™] you can have non-removable teeth in just one day. Prior to the introduction of All-on-Four[™] technology, patients requiring permanent implants had to suffer uncomfortable and expensive procedures.

First developed in Europe, the All-on-Four[™] procedure places a complete arch of permanent teeth on four or five titanium implants. The implants are positioned on an angle to make the best use of the



bone and serve as a replacement for the root of your teeth. The teeth are held securely and because there is no upper palette as in a normal denture, patients don't lose their taste or texture sensation for the foods they eat.

And yes, it can all be completed in one day, followed by two or three follow-up appointments. Having the Permanent Teeth-In-A-Day, All-on-FourTM procedure generally involves little to no discomfort and very little swelling as compared to conventional dental implants.

Who are the best candidates?

Patients with total tooth loss in either or both the upper and lower part of their mouth are candidates, as well as patients with failing teeth that will likely require removal. It's also possible to have the implant placed in only the upper or lower part of your mouth so you can continue using your removable dentures on the opposite jaw.

If you've been told you aren't a candidate for other types of dental implants, or have little jaw bone, the All-on-FourTM procedure is likely an excellent solution for you. Due to remarkable advances in dental technology we are able to place these implants on patients with very little jaw bone.

Even if you don't wear dentures, you may still be a candidate for dental implants if:

- Your speech is affected by the empty spaces left by the missing teeth
- Your teeth are starting to drift into the spaces and food is getting caught in between your teeth
- You are concerned about what to do to replace the tooth or teeth you lost some time ago
- You are about to lose a tooth due to decay or trauma.



What are the Benefits of Permanent Teeth-In-A-Day?

Closest Thing to Having Natural Teeth!

When looking for a solution to replace your dentures or fix missing teeth, nothing equals the realism of a dental implant. After the implant has fused with your bone, the titanium screw can be fitted with a variety of dental prosthetics. So, even if you still have dentures on the upper or lower part of your mouth, your new dental implants will blend right in. You'll never have to worry about someone pointing out your prosthetic teeth, because they won't be able to tell the difference!

Cost Effective Way to Replace your Teeth

Cost is an important factor in many of life's decisions, and it's no different with your oral health, including dental implants. The Permanent Teeth-In-A-Day implants are typically the least expensive solution when compared with traditional methods of implants, which need to use more prosthetic teeth and often create a less-than-pleasing result. Also, many of the alternative options tend to not last nearly as long as a dental implant.

Other procedures often mean that the less than satisfactory prosthetic teeth must be replaced several times, or even worse, cause other dental issues, increasing your overall cost.


The All-on-Four™ Dental Implants Team
